CASE STUDY: Workplace Violence - Multiple Robberies

OVERVIEW

A national manufacturer of pneumatic rescue tools was suffering from multiple break-ins at their facility. Groups of masked men coordinated the break-ins while carrying firearms. Our team was contracted to investigate the break-ins and assist with the apprehension of the masked assailants.

CHALLENGES & SOLUTIONS

The company was concerned for the security of their premises along with their staff and assets due to the assailants carrying firearms. With the very credible threat of violence, ROWAN needed to provide a comprehensive security solution in collaboration with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

In collaboration with the local law enforcement agencies, our team conducted a thorough Threat, Vulnerability and Risk Assessment (TVRA) of the facility, establishing the weaknesses in their current security procedures and establishing how the assailants were able to continually breach the existing security measures. This allowed us to develop comprehensive Counter Surveillance Measures (CSM) as well as establishing a team of plain clothed agents who monitored the site on a 24 hour basis until the assailants were apprehended.

By utilizing the expertise of the ROWAN team, we were able to successfully assist the local, state and federal law enforcement teams in identifying the assailants, while avoiding any further harm to the business or their assets.
